GATE ENTRY SYSTEM – VISITORS

When your friends, family or visitors are coming into Summertree after 7pm, they will stop at the Gate House and use the Telephone Entry System. They have two options to contact you for entry at that point. They can use the A or Z button to scroll through the names and find yours. Once your name is highlighted they press the call button. Or **they can enter your 4 digit code on the keypad**, which is assigned to you automatically by the software. Both ways will call the phone number you gave us. On your end, **press the number 9** on your phone to activate the gates to open.

NOTE: If you have had issues with your entry bar code on your car working at the gate, please make note of the 5 digit number on the bar code and call the office at 727-856-2332 so Sheila or Kara can check and update the system if necessary.
