Managers Report:

Summertree Residents,

- The <u>HOA dues</u> should be paid no later than the 1st. If you send your payment through the mail, please send with plenty of time in advance, as the mail has been exceptionally slow, and you will acquire late fees if your check is not processed on time. You may sign up for ACH to have your dues come out automatically, or you may sign into your account and pay via credit card, to avoid any late fees. The next payment is due **October 1st, 2024.**
- <u>Notary services</u> are available in the SRF office free of charge, between the hours of 9:00 AM- 3:00 PM only.
- The <u>Water Aerobics</u> class has priority during their class time of 10 AM- 11 AM
 Tues- Sat. The class will be using the shallow end of the pool while the deep end
 will be available for other swimmers. Swimming laps is not allowed while their
 class is in session.
- If you have <u>visitors coming after 7 PM</u>, please inform them that they cannot
 drive behind a vehicle going through the entrance gate. The arm is timed and
 will come down on your vehicle causing possible damage or breaking the gate
 arm.
- For <u>Amazon deliveries</u>, please include in your delivery instructions to only deliver between the hours of 6:00 AM and 7:00 PM, and to not leave packages at the front gate. We have had issues with Amazon leaving resident's important packages at the front gate, leaving them vulnerable for theft.
- Please be mindful when <u>driving your golf cart, motorized scooter, bicycle, or walking your pets in Summertree</u>. You should have lights on in the dark, so others can see you to avoid an accident. If you see a car coming your way, please move to the side of the road to allow them to pass.

GATE ENTRY SYSTEM – VISITORS

When your friends, family or visitors are coming into Summertree after 7pm, they will stop at the Gate House and use the Telephone Entry System. They have two options to contact you for entry at that point. They can use the A or Z button to scroll through the names and find yours. Once your name is highlighted they press the call button. Or they can enter your 4 digit code on the keypad, which is assigned to you automatically by the software. Both ways will call the phone number you gave us. On your end, press the number 9 on your phone to activate the gates to open.

NOTE: If you have had issues with your entry bar code on your car not working at the gate, please make note of the 5 digit number on the bar code and call the office at 727-856-2332 so Sheila or Kara can check and update the system if necessary.
