Important Dues Information:

The SRF Coupon Books have been mailed. Please note, quarterly dues have increased from \$207.00 to \$213.00. As a reminder, payments for Summertree Recreation Facility assessments are due January 1st, April 1st, July 1st, and October 1st. Payments are considered late after the 10th of the month the payments are due. If payments are not received by the 20th of the that month, late fees, admin fees and interest will be applied. This does not apply to Pointe West residents, as your payment is wrapped up in your HOA dues.

- If you have your payments set up to come out on the website, you
 have to go in and change the amount to \$213.00.
- For Homeowners setup on ACH by us, the auto debit will be for the new fees.
 You don't need to do anything. We'll send you ACH letters notifying you of the new fees we will be debiting out of your bank account.
 - If you have it set up as a bank payment, you have to change the
 amount to \$213.00. Bill Payments are setup and controlled by
 the Homeowner on their bank's online banking platform. We
 have neither access to your profile nor set up to make any changes.
 So, you will have to change the amount on the portal.

<u>GEOTHERMAL POOL SYSTEM</u>

Prior to installing a geothermal system the pool was heated by propane. In the late spring the heaters would be turned off and the Florida Sun did the rest for heating the pool. At times the pool would reach 91 degrees as Florida Summer heated up. There was no cooling system in place. We now use a geothermal system to heat and cool the pool. You could just call it a heating and cooling pump. There are four electronic sensors that will heat and cool on demand. One for the hot tub and three for the pool.

In the winter the geothermal takes heat from the water in the pond and exchanges it with the cooler pool water through a heat exchanger. The pond water never mixes with the pool water for heating or cooling. In the summer, geothermal works in reverse, taking away the pool's warmth and drawing cold from the pond water through the heat exchanger. The water taken in from the pond equals the water going back out to the pond so there is no effect on the pond's water level. The water going back to the pond is colder in the winter an warmer in the summer since the heat of cold from the pool has to get taken away in exchange for the heat or cold from the pond. Think about how an air conditioner expels warm air to the outside while it cools the inside. The same principle applies. We have a large pool so it will take time for the temperature to cool down as the geothermal works against the hot Florida Sun.

GATE ENTRY SYSTEM – VISITORS

When your friends, family or visitors are coming into Summertree after 7pm, they will stop at the Gate House and use the Telephone Entry System. They have two options to contact you for entry at that point. They can use the A or Z button to scroll through the names and find yours. Once your name is highlighted they press the call button. Or they can enter your 4 digit code on the keypad, which is assigned to you automatically by the software. Both ways will call the phone number you gave us. On your end, press the number 9 on your phone to activate the gates to open.

NOTE: If you have had issues with your entry bar code on your car not working at the gate, please make note of the 5 digit number on the bar code and call the office at 727-856-2332 so Sheila or Kara can check and update the system if necessary.
