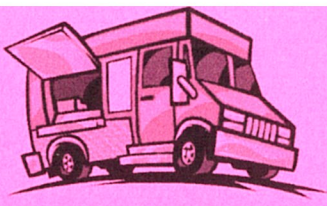
Besides food, the Mission provides numerous services to homeless and low-income individuals in this area.

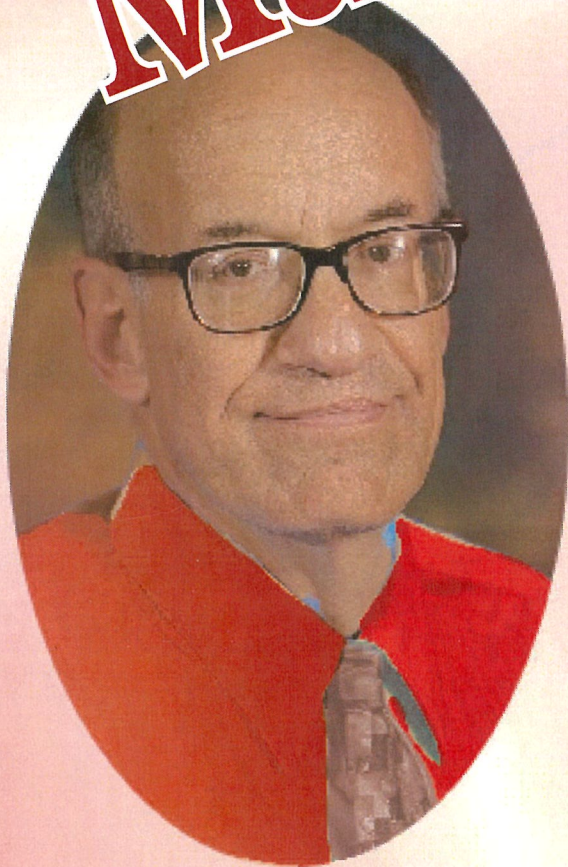

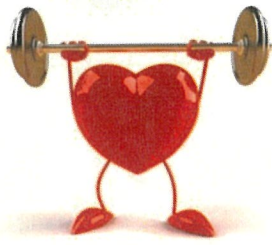
