## PREVENT PACKAGE THEFT

- REQUEST A SPECIFIC DELIVERY TIME FOR WHEN YOU'RE HOME
- HAVE PACKAGES DELIVERED TO A TRUSTED FRIEND
- PROVIDE DELIVERY INSTRUCTIONS, SO PACKAGES ARE LEFT OUT OF SIGHT FROM THE STREET OR HELD FOR IN-PERSON PICK UP



## PREVENT SCAMS

- BLOCK UNWANTED CALLS & TEXT MESSAGES
- DON'T GIVE YOUR PERSONAL OR FINANCIAL INFORMATION IN RESPONSE TO A REQUEST YOU DIDN'T EXPECT
- NEVER PAY SOMEONE WHO INSISTS YOU PAY WITH A GIFT CARD OR USE A MONEY TRANSFER SERVICE

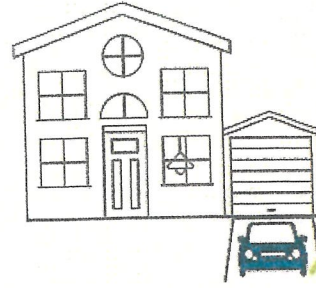

## COMPLETE A HOME SAFETY EVALUATION

- ENSURE ALL EXTERIOR DOORS & WINDOWS LOCKS WORK
- NEVER LEAVE A SPARE KEY NEAR DOORS
- SECURE BELONGINGS IN A SHED OR GARAGE
- CHECK THAT GATE LATCHES & FENCES WORK & ARE CLOSED
- KEEP PLANTS TRIMMED TO ELIMINATE HIDING SPOTS



## SIGNS OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING

LOOK FOR:

- LACK OF PERSONAL POSSESSIONS & IDENTIFICATION CARDS
- PHYSICAL SIGNS OF ABUSE, SUCH AS BRUISING
- SOCIALLY DISCONNECTED, INABILITY TO SPEAK ALONE & REHEARSED ANSWERS

## PREVENT CAR BURGLARIES

- NEVER LEAVE YOUR CAR UNATTENDED WHILE RUNNING
- CLOSE AND LOCK ALL CAR DOORS & WINDOWS



# SCAMS FOCUSED ON THE ELDERLY



## PROTECT YOURSELF FROM SCAMS



### PHONE SCAMS

Scammers posing as reputable agencies or companies call or text requesting personal information or money. If you receive one of these calls or texts, hang up and delete the number.

### PHISHING EMAIL SCAMS

The victim receives an email or text claiming they won a prize or their computer requires an update or contains a virus. Don't click on links or attachments before verifying the source.



### GRANDPARENT SCAM

Victims of this scam receive a phone call from someone impersonating their grandchild, requesting money because they were in an accident. Before sending money, verify the contact.

### DOOR-TO-DOOR SOLICITATION SCAMS

A scammer knocks on your door offering a product or service. If you're not expecting someone at your home, use caution and always ask who the individual is associated with.



### ADDITIONAL WAYS TO STAY SAFE

Pasco Sheriff's Office urges citizens to be cautious of people demanding immediate payment. Don't send cash or gift cards to unknown individuals through the mail or ride share companies. Additionally, never provide personal or financial information to an unsolicited request from an unverified individual.
