Summertree residents,

We had a great turnout for Breakfast With The Sheriff. Some key takeaways that Sherriff Nocco wanted to get across are the rise of scams being circulated through either text message or emails.

- People are getting texts for past due toll notices. This is a scam. Do not click on the link. Calls for jury duty and saying there is a warrant for your arrest or you can pay \$5,000.00 to get rid of it is a scam, as there will never be a call if you have a warrant.
- Sextortion-People will send a nude photo and ask for a photo in return. Then they will tell you to pay money or they will share your photo on social media. This is usually happening to kids or loved ones.

To help protect yourself against scams, block unwanted calls. Do not give out your personal information, such as social security number or financial information. Do not pay anyone who is demanding money. Never pay someone who is asking for payment in the form of gift cards or money transfer services.

The crime rate in Summertree is extremely low. Residents should make sure they keep their doors, garages, and automobiles locked, which will help keep crime rate low. Make sure to follow Sheriff Nocco's "9 PM Routine" (Please see Crime Prevention Tips flyer).

If you have a camera system at your home, make sure the video quality is high enough to make out the faces of people and not too blurry.

GATE ENTRY SYSTEM – VISITORS

When your friends, family or visitors are coming into Summertree after 7pm, they **MUST** stop at the Gate House and use the Telephone Entry System at the kiosk to the left. They have two options to contact you for entry at that point.

 They can use the A or Z button to scroll through the names and find yours. Once your name is highlighted they press the call button.

2. Or they can enter your 4 digit code on the keypad. If you do not know your code, please contact the SRF office to obtain it.

Please note: Some phones are set up to block unknown numbers or phone calls that may be spam. If there is an issue with the callbox not calling the phone number you provided to SRF, please save the callbox phone number into your phone. **727-857-0704.**

Both ways will call the phone number you gave us. On your end, **press the number 9** on your phone to activate the gates to open.

NOTE: If you have had issues with your entry bar code on your car not working at the gate, please make note of the 5 digit number on the bar code and call the office at 727-856-2332 so Sheila or Kara can check and update the system if

necessary.
