MANAGER'S REPORT

Summertree Residents,

As summer approaches, we should be mindful of our neighbors and abide by the rules set forth in the Rules and Regulations.

Some important rules regarding the pool and hot tub are:

- ALL pool users must rinse off before entering or re-entering the pool or the hot tub. Soaps and shampoos are only to be used in the restrooms. No personal grooming is allowed in the pool area.
- Shirts or bathing suit cover-ups are required at all times outside the pool deck area.
- Per Florida state law, the safety line must be connected in the swimming pool at all times.
- The morning water aerobics class is restricted to the shallow end of the pool and has priority over individual swimmers for using that end of the pool.
- Everyone must use earbuds or headphones if they wish to listen to music in the pool area.
- A resident or guest who opens an umbrella is responsible for closing it when their party leaves the pool area, regardless of whether there are other persons at the pool, unless another person there agrees to accept responsibility for lowering it when they leave.

Alligator mating season started in April, with its peak being in May and June. "Alligators have a keen sense of smell and can detect dogs, often viewing them as easy prey. They are attracted to the scent of small animals, including pets, and can smell blood from up to a mile away. Keep dogs on a leash and away from water's edge in alligator habitats". A rule of thumb is stay six feet from the waters edge, and avoid peak feeding times, which is dusk and dawn. As a reminder, there is NO fishing permitted on SRF property.

Bicycle and Golf Cart Safety Rules

- Bicycles and motorized vehicles must use roads only. Bicycles are prohibited from sidewalks.
- Bicyclists must ride on the right side of the road, as near to the curb as possible, and with the flow of vehicular traffic.
- Bicyclists riding in groups of two or more must ride single file on the right side of the road, as near to the curb as possible.
- Bicyclists must always proceed at a safe speed. Racing is expressly prohibited anywhere on SRF property.
- Bicyclists must observe all traffic signs, signals, lights, and markings, as they would if they were operating an automobile.
- There are spaces reserved for golf cart parking adjacent to the bocce courts.
